

Tool & Die Technician/Journeyman

Objective: Tool & Die Technician will be responsible for servicing and maintaining metal stamping dies. Regrinding and sharpening various cutting details and components, polishing and redressing drawing and forming components. Responsibilities will include insuring the proper function of all working die details and components including mechanical components such as cams, springs, pressure pads, etc., in press troubleshooting, maintenance and repair, using all common tool room equipment to fabricate new parts or make repairs. Duties may also include continual upgrading of dies including installing die protection sensors, lube systems, etc.
