RESPONSIBILITIES:

Sewing processes include: binding, tacking and straight stitch. Other assembly processes include cutting, gluing, grommet machines, and hand assembly of products. The candidate for this position must:

- Work safely
- Achieve acceptable daily output in a fast-paced, results oriented environment
- Maintain excellent attendance, including overtime when needed
